For men to discuss issues in relation to prostate cancer.  
The third Wednesday of every month  
from 2pm - 3:30pm in the Resource Room.

### **Support Group for Spouses & Significant Others of Men Diagnosed with Prostate, Testicular or Bladder Cancer**

For spouses and significant others affected by prostate, testicular or bladder cancer.

### **When Someone Has A Serious Illness**

A support group to help children understand and express feelings when someone in their family has a serious illness.
